Service Luther Memorial since 1994, the Allen Organ MDS-95 is a unique model from this early Digital instrument manufacturer. This instrument is a fine example of digital technology from the time period with an audio system of 26 independent channels. The main organ is installed in the gallery with Solo and Pedal divisions housed in the center casework towers, Great and Swell positioned on each side shelf of the ceiling, and the Ruck-Positiv installed in the suspended case on the balcony rail. The entire organ is duplicated behind the 1926 M.P. Moller façade in the chancel under Antiphonal control. Voicing of the instrument was supervised and customized by Kevin Sadowski, former Cantor, to reflect a more Northern-Germanic approach to organ tonality with influence of French organ building in the Solo reeds.
